## Service Detail

### Primary Source Verification

Fully digital workflows with automated, event-driven notifications help practitioners keep data up-to-date.

Application is fully digital and dynamic, asking only the questions that are necessary based on practitioner responses

Application data is digitally stored so that practitioners need only update when data changes and reattest.

Dental Hub verifies all sources required by NCQA and CMS standards, and then some. Sources presently include:

- National Provider ID (NPI)
- Highest Level of Education
- Board Certification
  - Residency
  - Degree
  - State Licensure
- Anesthesia
- CDS
- DEA
- Malpractice History/Actions (NPDB)
- Death Master Index
- OIG
- SAM
- All published State Medicaid Termination/Exclusion Lists
- Medicare Opt-out
- Medicare Preclusion List
- OFAC

Practitioners also must verify:

- Malpractice insurance
  - Practitioners must also attach their malpractice policy face sheet in states that require it
- Hospital affiliations

Practitioners further must explain any gaps in work history that are greater than 6 months.

Payer-specific requirements available for an additional fee

### Credentialing Committee Decisions

The optional credentialing committee service includes:

- Decision to approve or deny each application
- Automated, payer-specific notifications sent immediately upon decision (via Dental Hub notification and email)

Management of all credentialing appeals

### Ongoing Monitoring

The optional ongoing monitoring service includes monitoring of expirables and sanctions.

Expirables monitoring includes:

- Checking the following credentials upon expected expiration:
  - State license
  - Controlled Dangerous Substances (CDS) license
  - Drug Enforcement Agency (DEA) license
- Checking the following credentials upon expected expiration:
  - State license number on file with state
  - Expiration date on file with state

Sanctions monitoring includes checking the following databases on a monthly basis:

- Published state license websites;
- Published state Medicaid exclusion sites;
- Exclusions Database published by the U.S. Department of Health & Human Services, Office of Inspector General ("OIG"); and
- U.S. General Services Administration's System for Award Management Database ("SAM").
